

INSTRUCTION & CARE MANUAL

Locate the waterproof compartment where the ON/OFF Switch and Battery Housing are located. Remove the compartment top by unscrewing it. Press the ON/OFF switch to illuminate the unit and press it again to turn off the lights.


Battery Installation & Replacement Requires: 3 x AAA Batteries

- 1. Open the waterproof compartment.
- 2. Remove the plastic tab if there is one in the compartment.
- Check to see if the unit is operational by pressing the ON/OFF switch. If the unit does not turn, it is time to change the batteries.
- 4. Use a Philips screwdriver to unlock the battery housing.
- 5. Remove the expired AAA batteries if any
- Insert new batteries into the housing, making sure to properly match polarities. The lights will not function if the polarities do not match up accordingly.
- 7. Screw the battery housing lid back on tightly.
- 8. Screw the plastic compartment lid back firmly into place.

CARE & HANDLING

- . Do not submerge the unit in any liquids other than water
- · Keep the unit dry when not in use
- . Do not place the unit near powerful, unshielded magnets
- Do not expose the unit to extreme hot or cold temperatures
- . Do not hit, drop, or smash the unit
- \bullet Do not disassemble the unit for any reason
- · Remove batteries from unit when not in use
- Do no mix different types of batteries like Alkaline, Zinc, or Rechargeable Batteries
- Do not use the product without properly securing the waterproof compartment
- · Product not intended for use by children
