

Power Advantages Super Bright Life Lantern is the perfect solution for your mobile lighting needs. Good for up to 100,000 hours of use, use the Super Bright Life Lantern for roadside emergencies; on your next camping trip; while fishing or hunting; evening patio cookouts; on your next picnic or while at the beach. This powerful lantern shines in all 360 degrees and comes with an easy carry handle and a wide sturdy. There is also a dial on the front where you can adjust the brightness your Super Bright Life Lantern to your lighting needs. The Super Bright Life Lantern is powered by four (4) "D" batteries (not included) or you can use a 6V AC adapter (not included) Installing Batteries:

- Locate the battery compartment on the bottom of the Lantern.
- Remove the battery compartment cover by rotating it in a counter-clockwise direction.
- Remove the battery housing and insert 4 "D" batteries, making sure to match the polarities ("+" and "-") as indicated in the battery housing.
- Replace the battery housing, making sure to match up the flat side of the housing to the flat side of the inside of the lantern.
- Replace the battery compartment by rotating it in a clockwise direction.

**Optional AC Power:** To prolong the life of your batteries, you can choose to power the Lantern using an AC adaptor (not included). Plug one end of the AC adaptor into the Lantern, and the other end into any standard wall outlet. How to Use:

- To turn the Lantern on, simply locate the dial on the front of the Lantern and turn clockwise.
- To use the dimmer option, turn the dial until you have achieved the desired amount of brightness.
- Turn the Lantern off by the dial counter-clockwise until the lights turn off.

**NOTE:** Do not force the dial past its limits of movement. Doing so will result in damage to you Lantern. **IMPORTANT:**

- Turn Lantern off when not in use.
- Remove batteries if left unused for long periods.
- Adult supervision is recommended.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries.
- Alkaline batteries are recommended for best use.
- Do not use new and old batteries at the same time.
- Be sure to install batteries with polarities aligned correctly.
- When batteries are exhausted, remove them from Lantern to prevent damage or danger.
- Do not dispose of in a fire as batteries may explode or leak.
- The LED light is very bright; do not look directly into the LED when it is in use.
